Assembly:

This model is designed to be printed on 110# cardstock, then cut out and taped together. Once assembled, it can be painted, or otherwise decorated.

Accuracy in cutting and edge alignment will make assembly easier. There are three major sections to the sculpture:

A, B, & C, as indicated on the patterns. The numbers indicate matching edges.

So, start by matching A1 to A1 using the alignment dot. Apply a ~1/2" x 1/2" piece of transparent tape across the joint. Work toward the corners aligning the edges and applying small pieces of tape.

Continue until the three main sections are assembled. Then, make the matching smiley faces kiss to position and attach the sections. Those joints can be glued or taped.

Have fun! Be creative in your decorating.
